Categories: Amateurs & Kids (12 & Under)

Judging: Judging will be conducted by local judges. All decisions are final. Entries will be judged on the basis of taste, appearance, and texture. Judging will begin promptly at 1pm.

Regulations:

1. All entries must be received at the Newton Fire Museum between the hours of 11:00 & 12:30pm on the date of the contest. Parking is available in the rear. Late entries cannot be judged, but are welcome and appreciated as part of the tasting.
2. A "Kid" is defined as: Anyone 12 years of age or under.
3. Each entry should be accompanied by two (2) recipe cards submitted on index card. One should have the contestant's name on it. The other will be used for judging and should not have the contestant's name on it.
4. Each entry must be a complete recipe (a full batch of cookies, whole cake or pie)
5. Recipes do not need to be your own creation, but may simply be your favorite.
6. Multiple entries are welcome, but must be accompanied by an entry form and two (2) recipe cards.
7. Please use disposable platters. We cannot be responsible for the return of platters.
8. Following judging, the public will be invited to "sample" the entries through the purchase of "Taste Tickets."
